EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six (6) months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be reinstated.

Item #2, Mobile Home Unit Site: WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee, the number of unit sites and a final inspection. Item #25, Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold-water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

VIII. Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Fairfield Township or the Plumbing Inspector. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location. Schedule permitting, an inspector will respond to an inspection request within 2 business days to schedule the inspection. The inspector will typically perform the inspection within 5 business days as his or her schedule permits.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 360 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 360 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 360 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
